COMMUNITY CLINIC STAFF, PATIENTS, AND SUPPORTERS TO RALLY AGAINST REPEAL AND DISMANTLE OF ACA

Locals Rally at Valley Community Healthcare Centers as Part of Organized Demonstration in Los Angeles

Joining a county-wide initiative to save affordable health care for all, VCH board members, staff, patients and local supporters will unite for a rally outside Valley Community Healthcare's North Hollywood and North Hills Wellness Center sites on **Thursday, March 23 from 12noon-1:00pm.**

The effort responds to a call to action by the Community Clinic Association of Los Angeles to fight against the threat a repeal of the ACA poses to the health and wellbeing of 1.5 million county patients currently covered by Medic-Aid and Covered California. Of 25,000 VCH patients, 29% or 7,400 stand to lose their coverage if the ACA is repealed.
