We are seeking a **Behavioral Health Clinician I**. This position requires strong clinical skills in both mental health and substance abuse prevention and treatment. We serve individuals, couples, families and groups; children, adolescents, adults and seniors. Behavioral Health Clinicians use strengths-based, resilience and recovery models in conceptualizing the health and wellbeing of our patients. We endorse fully integrated care and harm reduction. BHS clinicians are expected to be flexible in function and role; able to effectively adapt in a fast-paced, non-traditional clinical setting using developmentally and culturally sound best practices.

Essential Job Functions:

1. Screening and diagnostic assessment using standardized tools and the DSM-5
2. Provide evidenced based practices to individuals, couples, families, and groups – knowledge of CBT and DBT are essential.
3. Document in Electronic Health Records in a timely and accurate way
4. Submit billing daily that is accurate and complete
5. Effectively communicate with all staff, volunteers, and community partners
6. Provide patient advocacy as needed
7. Maintain 80% direct patient service that focuses on patient outcomes
8. Other duties as assigned



Minimum Qualifications:

1. Master's degree in social work or psychology
2. Three to five years minimum clinical experience required and supervisory experience preferred
3. Knowledge of the Hispanic/Latino culture is a must
4. Bilingual/Spanish Preferred
5. Knowledge of integrated behavioral health; mental health recovery, harm reduction, age specific growth and development, crisis and behavior management is expected
6. Working knowledge of administrative practices and procedures, HIPPA regulations, policies and standards related behavioral health
7. Having flexibility to occasionally work evenings and Saturdays is expected.
